## RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO CITY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT TO ADOPT THE UPDATED MCCSD EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN

WHEREAS, the Mendocino City Community Services District (MCCSD), together with partner agencies, shares responsibility for managing risks and responding to emergencies ranging from natural disasters like earthquakes and droughts, to human-caused disasters like hazardous materials spills and other accidents; and

**WHEREAS,** MCCSD is committed to increasing its disaster resilience, protecting health and safety of staff, reducing the risks to public health, neighbors and individuals, and efforts to maintain adequate wastewater treatment during emergency conditions; and

WHEREAS, MCCSD follows the Standardized Emergency Management System (SEMS) and the National Incident Management System (NIMS) and maintains an emergency plan that specifies the policies, roles, resources and practices of MCCSD and partner agencies before, during and after an emergency; and

**WHEREAS,** MCCSD has completed a 2024 update to the Emergency Action Plan in compliance the MCCSD NPDES Discharge Permit No. Ca0022870, Order Number No R-1-2022-0001; and

**WHEREAS,** the updated Emergency Action Plan has been reviewed by MCCSD staff and will replace MCCSD's previous Emergency Plan; and

**WHEREAS,** the updated Emergency Action Plan will be augmented over time with appendices specific to MCCSD and will be reviewed regularly to ensure it is kept up-to-date; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED,** that the Board of Directors of the MCCSD does hereby adopt the 2024 Updated MCCSD Emergency Action Plan.
